- Mentoring focuses on developing employees' skills therefore judges will be assessing the verbal communication between the mentor and apprentice as well as the skill level achieved from this communication

 1. Set in rollers and dried (hair must not be combed or brushed after drying until the competition begins)
 2. Hair hanging free, dried or wet, not pre-sectioned, braided or in a ponytail.

- Song name and artist to be given to HBIA two weeks prior to the event
