



HBIA Australian Hairdressing and Beauty Competitions 2017 - Frequently Asked Questions

What does Hair 'Raw' mean

Raw means hair free from any styling or finishing

Styling Iron Competition

Product can be already in the hair prior to commencement of this competition. Models should present to scrutineering with product already dried in.

Can I utilise hair pieces

If the competition does not state that you cannot use hairpieces then you are permitted to use them. A guideline is to remain true to the competition and make sure you can still see 30/50% of the hair

Can I use pastel colour in the Bombshell Blonde

Again if the criteria does not state that you cannot include pastels then you can. Remember to stay true to the competition and in this example the pastel colour would need to be a 9 or above. This competition is about the blonde. If you are keen to utilise pastels perhaps consider the Unicorn Colour competition.

Practical Competition for Ladies Cutting

For the practical ladies cutting hair must be presented in its raw state. No styling or prep work may be done prior to the commencement of the competition. Hair must be flowing freely. Competitors will get the chance to wet hair down on stage before competition starts.

Does models clothes or overall look contribute to the scoring.

Yes clothing and total look do matter. Particularly if the competition is close in regards to the hair work. Judges will then be looking for a point of difference which will be the overall look and finishing and how well this all comes together.



Scrutineering

Scrutineering will take place at the front of the ballroom and models must present to scrutineering 20 minutes before competition time.

Payment

All payment must be received with competition entries. All payment must be received before the 28th May and payment can be made over the phone.

Photographic

You do not need to be present for photographic judging at 9am. However recommend you attend the awards ceremony at approximately 5.30pm.

Test & Tag

Test and Tag is available outside of the ballroom on the day of the event. All electrical equipment must be tagged with date and proof of tag and testing. Faulty equipment can trip the power system which would be devastating on the day. Tag & Testing is at a cost of \$10 per appliance on the day.

Spectators

Spectators can buy tickets on the day at a cost of \$25 per person. Children under 12 are free.

Appropriateness

All models should be appropriately covered without genitalia showing. For Runway events understand that current music trends at times do have explicit language. Please just be mindful that there may be children present in the audience. A song which has explicit language every second word would not be accepted.

Judges

The Judges decision is final and will not be entered into.
